This partnership allows easy access for Chicago students to pursue a bachelor's degree in either Air Traffic Control Management or Aviation Administration.

# aviation programs

**Lewis University provides students with the education necessary to excel in today's aviation industry.** Our comprehensive degree programs allow students to select from a diverse range of aviation instruction. Once a student completes an associate's degree at one of the City Colleges of Chicago, they may be eligible for admission with the Lewis University Aviation Academy located at De La Salle Institute in Chicago.\* This will be a comprehensive aviation program that allows students to take evening classes as well as online classes to complete an aviation degree in:

## Air Traffic Control Management

- Designed for students interested in working as air traffic controllers.
- Lewis is one of only 36 Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) approved by Air Traffic Collegiate Training Initiative (CTI) programs in the country and the only program in the state of Illinois.
- Our program provides graduates with fundamental air traffic control knowledge and technical understanding through classroom and laboratory instruction.
- Graduates qualify for entry into the FAA ATC Academy, where training is completed.



## Aviation Administration

- Designed to prepare students for careers as professional managers in aviation.
- Provides students with a background in both aviation and business administration.
- Career opportunities include management positions in the airline industry, aircraft manufacturing industry, governmental agencies, airport management and others.


## Faculty

## *transfer credit* from city colleges of chicago

**Admission consideration into the Lewis University Aviation Academy requires that students have completed at least 39-45 credit hours of general education courses within the associate's degree plan.** By completing approved courses from the Illinois Articulation Initiative (IAI) General Education Core Curriculum, transfer students can be confident that those courses will transfer to Lewis without any problems.

The Lewis University Office of Admission will make admission decisions based on the likelihood of success in a student's chosen major. Transfer students must have at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA and be in good academic standing with their most recent college. Students wishing to pursue a bachelor's degree in Air Traffic Control Management must have earned a minimum of a 3.0 cumulative GPA for admission consideration.

Students are required to submit a completed application and official transcripts from all previously attended institutions.
