Transfer Student Admission Criteria

- A transfer student applicant is defined as a degree-seeking student who has earned a minimum of 12 semester (18 quarter) hours of transferable credit at a regionally accredited post-secondary institution. Programs are offered in 16-Week semesters.
- Official transcripts from all colleges/universities attended must be sent to the Office of Undergraduate Admission. An evaluation of courses and hours still needed will be forwarded by the Office of Admission.
- Transfer student applicants need to have earned a minimum 2.0 cumulative transfer Grade Point Average (higher for some majors) based upon all transferable courses to be considered for admission. The Office of Undergraduate Admission will fully review a student's file to determine the likelihood of success at Lewis University.

Accelerated Student Admission Criteria

- Accelerated programs offer students an opportunity to complete a degree program with classes that start every 8 weeks.
- Candidates for admission need a minimum of 30 semester hours of transferable credit at a regionally accredited post-secondary institution and have significant work experience to contribute to the class discussions.
- A personal statement and official transcripts from all colleges previously attended are required to complete the application decision letter from the Office of Admission.
