Transfer Students

- A transfer student applicant (traditional programs) is defined as a degree-seeking student who has earned a minimum of 12 semester (18 quarter) hours of transferable credit at a regionally accredited post-secondary institution.
- Official transcripts from all colleges/universities attended must be sent to the Office of Undergraduate Admission. An evaluation of courses and hours still needed will be forwarded by the Office of Admission.
- Transfer student applicants need to have earned a minimum 2.0 cumulative transfer Grade Point Average (higher for some majors) based upon all transferable courses to be considered for admission. The Office of Undergraduate Admission will fully review a student's file to determine the likelihood of success at Lewis University. Transfer students must be in good standing at the most recently attended institution.
