Study Abroad Application

Congratulations on deciding to apply for a study abroad program at Lewis University!

This packet contains the instructions and application materials that will need to apply for a Lewis Travel Study, semester, academic year, or summer study abroad program. Applications will be accepted on a rolling admissions basis until the end of the business day on the deadline date. The program deadlines are:

Fall and Summer programs:	February 28
Spring programs:	September 15
Travel Study programs:	Varies. Refer to the faculty leader or the program's web page.

To apply to a Lewis program, you will need to submit the following to the International Study Abroad office:

- **Completed application** (be sure to include):
 - o Your full name as it appears/will appear in your passport
 - o Photo (attached to application, 2"x2", showing face)
 - o Application essays
- Official copy of **Your Lewis University transcripts** (An official copy, which may be obtained from the Office of the Registrar or ordered on-line. If you are applying to a Travel Study program, unofficial transcripts printed from the Lewis website are acceptable)
- **Two (2) Academic Recommendations** (these should be from professors who are familiar with your academic work)

Your submission of this application is not a guarantee of acceptance. Once you have turned in all of the materials mentioned above, the International Study Abroad office will review your application and make a decision about your acceptance into semester or summer program. You will be promptly notified in writing of the decision. Decisions concerning acceptance into a Lewis Travel Study program will be made by the faculty leading the program to which you have applied.

If you are accepted to a semester or Academic Year program, you will also be registered for a one-credit International Experience Seminar course that will help prepare you for studying abroad.
