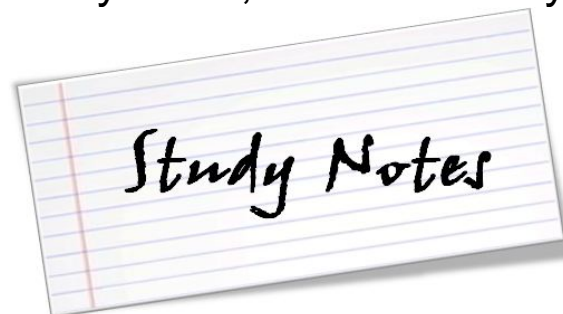

RE: 24-HOUR QUIET HOUR POLICY NOTICE

As stated in the Student Handbook, the 24-Hour Quiet Hour policy is in effect during the final two weeks of the semester to provide an environment conducive to study prior to final exams. This policy is in effect from **Sunday, April 30th through Sunday, May 14th**. If you are documented, you will be directed to appear in the Office of Residence Life located in the Student Union at 9:00 am the following day and may be required to move out of your hall by noon, that same day.
