## ONLY STUDENTS LOWING REQUIRMENTS MAY REMAIN ON CAMPUS DURING BREAK:

- Student workers required to work any dates/times that the residence halls are closed.
- Out-of-state students: The address the University has on file must confirm that you live out of state
- International students
- Athletes/Organizations in-season: Each team Coach submits an approved list of team members for break housing. Only athletes on these lists will receive an approved notice email.
- Students required to attend a class on any of the dates/times that residence halls are closed.

## Need to appeal a Spring Break Fine?

The Break Housing Appeals Board convenes for two sessions following each break. The board will hear individual appeals and make a recommendation about whether or not the fine should be upheld, waived or amended. Appeals will only be accepted when the appeals board is in session.

Appeals for Spring Break will be heard on **Thursday, March 15th at 3pm and on Friday, March 16th at 1pm**. These meetings will occur in the Residence Life Office in North Hall. Any student wishing to appeal a fine from Spring Break must do so in person at one of the listed meetings above.

**NO APPEALS WILL BE CONSIDERED OUTSIDE OF THESE TIMES OR BEYOND THE FINAL APPEAL DATE.**

## Ready to go home?

### What to do before you leave:

Room inspections will begin upon the departure of each student, starting no later than 6pm. The hall staff will inspect the room to ensure each student has done the following:

- ✓ **Unplug all electrical appliances** - including power strips, computers and televisions.
- ✓ **KEEP micro fridges and/or full size refrigerators plugged in**
- ✓ **Turn off the lights**
- ✓ **Lock all doors**
- ✓ **Close all windows**
- ✓ **Empty all trash cans**

Any policy violations will be documented and the appropriate fines will be assessed. Policy violations will be referred to the University Judicial System.
