



PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS AND AGREEMENT

The Success Scholars Program provides first-year students at Lewis an opportunity to further their growth and development from high school in order to excel as college students. Success Scholars join together in a small academic community where they benefit from mentorship from a peer and staff mentor as well as find support and inspiration from other Success Scholars. The Success Scholars Program begins in August and spans the entire first year at Lewis.

In order to help support student success in this program, the requirements indicated below have been established.

Students who elect to participate in the Success Scholars Program agree to participate in each of the following requirements:

- Attend, participate in, and complete all Success Scholars curricular and co-curricular programming during the summer Bridge Program
- Attend, participate in, and complete all Fall and Spring semester programming (see included academic calendar for details), including program feedback surveys
- Attend all bi-weekly meetings with the Success Scholars Program Coordinator and Graduate Assistant
- Attend all weekly meetings with a Peer Mentor
- Maintain at least a 1.75 GPA to remain in good academic standing
- Maintain at least a 2.0 GPA to continue financial scholarship eligibility
- Permit communication regarding student progress and well-being between program staff, instructors, parents and/or guardians
- Live the **Flyers Promise**
