Therefore, Lewis University is pleased to offer a **low cost** Student Fixed Indemnity Accident and Sickness Plan for our students.

Please consider this affordable Fixed Indemnity insurance plan for the following reasons:

- If you are a member of an HMO or PPO out of the area, please be certain of services available in the Romeoville, Illinois area. They may be limited!
- Your family policy may not cover you after you reach a certain age. Plan ahead; don't wait until this occurs and you find yourself without protection or with costly medical bills.

This plan, underwritten by Wellfleet Insurance Company, is outlined in a detailed flyer available from the Student Wellness Center, the Dean of Students Office or online at www.1stagency.com. Please note the following:

- The University provides Injury Insurance for all resident students, athletes and participants in Intramural activities at no cost to the student.
- All participants in Club Sports are not covered under any Lewis University insurance policy. Club Sport participants must obtain their own insurance coverage prior to participation.
- There is a Student Fixed Indemnity Accident and Sickness Plan available for all students at a cost of \$536.
- There is a Student Fixed Indemnity Accident and Sickness Plan available for a student's spouse and/or dependents for the 2023/2024 year.
- Coverage is available from August 1, 2023 to July 31, 2024.
